Fees:

Housing fees are all inclusive. Please indicate which housing option you prefer and how many people are using this option. In order to accommodate as many families as possible we cannot accommodate requests for "children's" rooms.

- There is no fee for children under the age of 2 years old.
- Children over the age of 2 will be charged at a rate of \$80 per child.

Housing Description:

#1 - Cabin accommodation @ \$110.00/person: Stay in camp cabins and truly experience camp! These cabins have bunk beds and share bathrooms with another family staying in the "sister" cabin.

#2 - Private Rustic accommodation @ \$175.00/person: These rooms are some of the more "rustic" rooms of camp. They offer large spaces with private bathrooms. Experience the history of camp as these are some of the original rooms from the first years of camp.

#3 - Semi-Deluxe accommodation @ \$195.00/person: These rooms are private rooms but do share a bathroom with an adjacent room.

#4 - Deluxe Conference Center room @ \$265.00/person: Housed in the Steve Breuer Conference center, these rooms have private bathrooms and offer internet access.

All housing reservations are taken on a first come, first serve basis.
